This psalm celebrates the enthronement of the king.

- 1Kings 1:38-40 the coronation of Solomon,
- 2Kings 11:12 the coronation of Joash. echoes of the taking of the ark into the city of David

Clap your hands, all you peoples! (2Samuel 6). Acclaim your God, singing for joy. For the Lord, the Most High, we must revere, great king over all the earth.

- Fear Awe in the presence of the sacred
 - Fear of divine punishment

There is no fear in love.

Perfect love casts out fear;

for fear has to do with punishment,
and whoever fears has not reached
perfection in love'(1John 4:18).
