

Education may be defined as drawing people into communion in the meanings and values that are the riches of our culture (including our Catholic culture), with a view to their contributing to these meanings and values.


#### Mark 1:21-27

Education / Teaching heals

• We all seem to ask, consciously or unconsciously: 'Am I significant?', 'Do I really mean anything to anybody?'

• This is not a curious question to be pondered on my own. It is a cry to others, for it really means: 'Am I significant to you?

• It is the question we ask of someone who is significant to us:

## • It is a love question

• We long to be ourselves for another. We long to be ourselves, and we know that this can only be in a love-relationship where the other person wants me to be myself and to be myself for them. When this happens, we are nurtured, we come alive, we grow, we blossom.

• When we are not confident that this question is being answered, we de




• Rather than undertake the inner and the outer journey to the heart and the mystery, we opt for false religion and a false god. We project a god in our own image, our own wishful thinking or our own fears. We grasp for security, even when it is meaningless and does not answer of radical questions. We cover one mask with another rather than stand naked before the truth.

• It is no wonder that many settle for agnosticism (the questions are too hard), or, faced with obviously false gods, for atheism (there is no god). Both these options leave our ultimate question unexplored.

## John-Paul II Mission of the Redeemer 28


