Jews living the covenant according to the way of Jesus:

(fulfilment : Messiah Son of God

Jews living the covenant according to the traditions and customs taught by 'the scribes and pharisees'.

Mark 1:21-28

They went to Capernaum; and when the sabbath came, he entered the synagogue and taught.

They were astounded at his teaching, for he taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.

Episode of man in the synagogue

At once his fame began to spread throughout the surrounding region of Galilee. Matthew 4:23-25

Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and curing every disease and every sickness among the people. So his fame spread throughout all Syria ... And great crowds followed him from Galilee, the Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea, and from beyond the Jordan.

Matthew 7:28-29

Jesus is the new Moses bringing the new Law down from the mountain

Exodus 24:12

YHWH said to Moses, "Come up to me on the mountain, and wait there; and I will give you the tablets of stone, with the law and the commandment, which I have written for their instruction."

Matthew 5:1-2

When Jesus saw the crowds, he went up the mountain; and after he sat down, his disciples came to him.

Then he began to speak, and taught them:

Matthew 5:17-20

Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets; I have come not to abolish but to fulfil.

For truly I tell you, until heaven and earth pass away, not one letter, not one stroke of a letter, will pass from the law until all is accomplished.

For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.

Love with God's love Matthew 5:43-48

You have heard that it was said, "You shall love your neighbour [Leviticus 19:18] and hate your enemy."

But I say to you, Love [agapan] your enemies and pray for those who persecute you

contrast Sirach 12:1-7

Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect.

and the poor have good news brought to them.


And blessed is anyone who takes no offence at me."
